

The committee in its meeting held on 13.08.2018 after due consideration and modification in the SOP and related formats resolved to approve for Ph.D. admission, submission and degree award process for Social Sciences as per UGC regulations, which has been forwarded to ANSISS, Patna vide letter no. 234, dated 19.01.2019. The committee also opined that the same may be adopted for other disciplines and the respective Deans may be invited for their consultation.

Further, the respective Deans of School of Health and Medicine, School of Engineering and Technology, School of Educational Training and Research and Academic (I/c), CNN, AKU were invited vide letter no. 4578, dated 27.10.2018 and letter No. 2779, dated 13.07.2019. The Deans of AKU resolved in its meeting held on 27.10.2018 and 13.07.2019 to allow the SOP and all forms related to Ph.D. Admission, submission and awarding of Degree process as per UGC Guidelines for Ph.D. in Social Science with some modifications for Ph.D. in Education and Nanoscience & Nanotechnology. However, the Deans of Health & Medicine and Engineering & Technology shall be consulted in next meeting for their valuable suggestion.

The aforesaid resolutions are being placed herewith for kind perusal. (Marked and attached as Annexure -IV at page no. 40-60).

Background:

A committee was constituted vide notification memo no. 006/Affili/149/AKU/2017 (Vol. III)-2572, dated 27.06.2019 for preparing draft Ordinance and Syllabus of Hospital Management Course. In light of the aforesaid notification, the committee in its meeting held on 28.06.2019 & 29.06.2019, submitted the draft Ordinance and Syllabus for the said course, which is being placed herewith for kind perusal. (Marked and attached as Annexure -XIII at page no. 329-362, 362 (a) & (b)).

The Academic Council was requested to provide approval on draft Ordinance and Syllabus of Bachelor in Hospital Management.

Resolution:

The draft Ordinance and Syllabus of Bachelor in Hospital Management is approved.

Discussion on draft Syllabus of M. Tech. in Micro Electronics & VLSI Technology and necessary amendment required in Ordinance of M. Tech. Programme.

Background:

In light of the direction received from Science & Technology Department, Government of Bihar vide Memo no. S.T. (VI)/TEQIP-III-01/2019-280, dated 23.01.2019 to start M. Tech. course in Micro Electronics & VLSI Technology in Bhagalpur College of Engineering, Bhagalpur and a request from the Principal, BCE, Bhagalpur vide letter no. 264, dated 28.02.2019 to issue No Objection Certificate(NoC) for the said course, the University issued the same vide letter no. 941, dated 06.03.2019.

In light of the aforesaid NoC issued by the University, AICTE, New Delhi vide letter no. F. No. Northern/1-4266933249/2019/EOA, dated 30.04.2019 has approved the said course to Bhagalpur College of Engineering, Bhagalpur with intake of 30 for 2019-20, which has been notified by the University u/s 4(2) of AKU Act, 2008 vide notification no. 003/Admn/093/AKU/2012-2545, dated 26.06.2019. The Principal, BCE, Bhagalpur has forwarded the aforesaid approval letter alongwith the draft syllabus of the said course vide letter no. 578, dated 01.06.2019. The draft syllabus of M. Tech. in Micro Electronics & VLSI Technology was placed before the committee of Principals of Affiliated Government Engineering Colleges of AKU in meeting dated 18.03.2019, as per the direction of the Registrar (I/c), AKU, Patna for their recommendation on the same which has been noted by the committee. The aforesaid documents are being placed herewith for kind perusal. (Marked and attached as Annexure -XIV at page no. 363-393).

The Academic Council was requested to provide necessary direction on draft Syllabus of M. Tech. in Micro Electronics & VLSI Technology and necessary amendment required in Ordinance of M. Tech. Programme.

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Agenda Item No. 23/15:

Discussion on Implementation of revised Curriculum of 04 subjects [History, Economics, Management (MBA) and Environment Science] of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) at P.G. level promulgated for its implementation in the Universities of Bihar received by the Governor's Secretariat vide Memo No. BSU (Regulation)-20/2019-2535/GS(I), Dated 08.10.2018.

Background:

In light of the direction received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar vide Memo No. BSU (Regulation)-20/2019-2535/GS(I), Dated 08.10.2018, the University constituted a Committee for implementation of the revised curriculum of MBA Programme vide letter no. 012/Acad/09-05/AKU/2016-1605, dated 26-04-2019. The aforesaid Committee in its meeting held on 27-04-2019 perused and discussed the Ordinance and Syllabus separately approved by the Academic Council in its 11th meeting held on 22.08.2016 and also approved by the Education Department, Govt. of Bihar vide memo no. 15/M 1-138/2015-1180, dated 14.06.2017, which has been notified by the University vide notification no. 12/Acad/09-03/AKU/2015 (Vol.IV)-3139, dated 21.07.2017.

After due discussion on curriculum of MBA received from Governor's Secretariat, Bihar, Rajbhawan, Patna vide Memo no. BSU (Regulation)-20/2019-2535/GS(I), dated 08.10.2018 and resolved to adopt the same from the session 2019-21 and further the committee suggested that the Ordinance for the same shall be finalized in the next meeting.

Apart from the above in light of the Letter of Approval (LoA) vide F.No. Northern/2019-20/1-4776955691, dated 30.04.2019 issued to the Chairman, Brajesh Kumar Foundation, Begusarai by AICTE, New Delhi, the committee of the University having subject experts discussed on dated 03.06.2019 regarding introduction of two new courses i.e. Masters in Marketing & Sales Management and Masters in Retail Management at the said Institute. The said committee was of the opinion that the existing syllabus of MBA programme of semester 1st and 2nd does not require any change. However, for Semester 3rd and 4th the syllabi required to be changed for conducting the aforesaid two courses. The Ordinance of MBA programme of AKU requires modifications accordingly to add the aforesaid two new courses.

In light of the opinion of the subject experts, the University constituted a committee vide letter no. 2757, dated 11.07.2019. The said committee in its meeting held on 13.07.2019 resolved to propose a draft amendment in light of the aforesaid direction received from the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar in the Ordinance of MBA programme and the other rules and regulations shall be applicable mutatis-mutandis.

The aforesaid resolution and letters are being placed herewith for kind perusal. (Marked and attached as Annexure -XXIII at page no. 697-756).

Bachelor in Mithila Folk Painting
(BMFP)

This ordinance may be called as "Ordinance for Bachelor in Mithila Folk Painting (BMFP) of Aryabhata Knowledge University, Patna. This programme shall be effective from academic session 2018-19.

1. Objective

- 1.1 To get excellence in their respective field by the students of Mithila Folk Painting and to get certain objectives of their creativity by stimulating their inner expressions. All information shall be provided about the medium/ subjects used in Mithila Folk Painting from the ancient period to the present day with the objective to make this programme could play a role for being traditional, individual, social and also the job oriented.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 A candidate seeking admission to BMFP Programme must satisfy the following conditions;
- 2.1.1 He/She must be an Intermediate/+2 level as a regular student or as a student of distance education.
- 2.1.2 Maximum age for admission in this course shall be 37 years.

3. Admission

- 3.1 Admission will be taken in the month of July in each Academic Year.
- 3.2 The candidates shall have to appear in written test (objective type) of 40 marks and practical test (painting) of 50 marks for getting selected for this programme. 10 marks shall be provided to the candidates having Certificate in Mithila Folk Painting or awarded in Madhubani Painting.
- 3.3 Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit which shall be prepared according to the marks obtained by the candidate in the test.
- 3.4 A candidate must have a fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- 3.5 A candidate should have communicable vocabulary, and should have the ability to read and write correctly in Hindi or English.

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- 3.6 Entrance Test fee shall be charged from the candidates. The amount of the test fee would be decided by AKU.
- 3.7 Entrance test will be conducted by AKU. Seat allotment will be done through counseling.
- 3.8 Reservation of seats for the candidate of reserved category shall be given as per Govt. rules.
- 3.9 A Certificate will be compulsory for such candidate, issued from a competent Government officer.
- 3.10 If reserve category seat remains vacant then it will be allotted to general category candidate.
- 3.11 If at any time it is found that the candidate has furnished any false information, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately and the deposited fee shall be forfeited and suitable legal action may be initiated.
- 3.12 In case of any controversy or irregularity pertaining to BMFP, the University (AKU) shall take the final decision as per approved Rules and Regulations
- 3.13 The University reserves the right to cancel the admission of any student at any stage of his study at the University on grounds of unsatisfactory academic performance, irregular and insufficient attendance, or indiscipline.
- 3.14 At the time of admission, the student is required to provide the following documents in original:
 - 3.14.1 Matric/ICSE/CBSE/NIOS/Other Board Certificate.
 - 3.14.2 Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination - +2 or Intermediate.
 - 3.14.3 Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination - +2 or Intermediate.
 - 3.14.4 College/School Leaving Certificate (CLC/SLC).
 - 3.14.5 Character Certificate of +2 or Intermediate.
 - 3.14.6 Migration Certificate (Not necessary for those from Bihar Board).
 - 3.14.7 Caste Certificate (from DM or competent authority for SC/ST/OBC/EBC/Differently Abled)

4. Total Number of Students

- 4.1 There shall be basic unit of 30 students, with a maximum of two units. This intake capacity may be modified by the University (AKU).

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5. Fee Structure

5.1 The fee shall be decided by the University from time-to-time.

6. Registration

6.1 All students must register themselves at the University within the fixed date notified by the University in the first semester itself.

7. Duration of Programme

7.1 The Bachelor in Mithila Folk Painting (BMFP) programme shall be of Three years duration. An academic year is divided into two semesters. In each semester, courses are offered in 15 teaching weeks and the remaining 5 weeks are to be utilized for conduct of examinations and evaluation purposes. Each week has at least 30 working hours spread over 6 days a week.

7.2 A candidate of the BMFP Programme shall undergo a regular course of study for Three Academic Years, that is, Six Semesters. Semester-I shall be from July to December and Semester-II shall be from January to May. There shall not be less than 90 working days, which shall comprise not less than 450 teaching/working hours for each semester. (Exclusive of the days for the conduct of CIA or external/ end-semester examinations).

8. Programme Structure

8.1 All subjects will have Lecture-Tutorial-Practical (L-T-P) components to indicate the contact hours and will have a credit count. Teaching of subjects will be reckoned in terms of credits.

8.2 The curriculum for BMFP programme shall include a "Project Work/ Group Work/ Study Tour & Project Presentation" in 3rd, 4th & 5th semester. The experience may be obtained in any reputed company/organization belonging to any industry, or any organization of comparable repute. The place of work has to get prior approval of the Institute. On completion of the project, the student shall submit a report to the department. The report of Project Work/ Group Work, etc. shall be followed by the viva-voce examination. If there is a serious difficulty in finding placements for project work, writing a Term Paper with empirical data can be considered under a competent faculty. This will be at the discretion of the Institute Authority.

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9. Examinations

- 9.1 There shall be examinations at the end of each semester as per the academic calendar of the University.
- 9.2 A candidate who does not pass the examination in any paper(s) shall be permitted to appear in such failed paper(s) in the subsequent examinations to be held in December/January or May/June. Those who fail in odd-semesters will appear in a subsequent examination of odd-semesters only. For example, if a student fails in a paper(s) in the 1st semester, s/he can appear in 3rd or 5th semester examinations only. The same applies to even-semesters. After the declaration of the result of the sixth semester examinations, special examinations will be conducted for clearing the backlog of 5th and 6th semesters.
- 9.3 A candidate should get enrolled/registered for the first semester examination. If enrollment/registration is not possible in the preceding semesters owing to shortage of attendance beyond condonation limit/ordinances prescribed OR belated joining OR on medical grounds, the candidates are not permitted to move to the next semester. Such candidates shall redo the semester in the following academic year as a regular student.
- 9.4 Student must have 75% of attendance in each course for appearing in the end Semester examination. A shortage of attendance upto 15% can be condoned by the Vice Chancellor as per AKU rules.


10. Passing of Examinations and Promotion Rules

- 10.1 A student will be promoted from second semester to the third semester and from fourth semester to the fifth semester if s/he has secured a minimum CGPA of 5.

11. Evaluation

- 11.1 Pattern of Evaluation of the End-semester examinations will be as per the rules of the University.
- 11.2 The performance of a student in each course is evaluated in terms of percentage of marks with a provision for conversion to grade points. Evaluation for each course shall be done by a continuous internal assessment (CIA) by the course teacher concerned as well as by an end semester examination and will be consolidated at the end of the course. The ratio of marks to be allotted to continuous internal assessment and to end semester examination is 40:60. The evaluation of practical work,

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wherever applicable, will also be based on continuous internal assessment and on an end-semester practical examination.

11.3 The details of the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) should be worked out by the Institute and a copy should be given to the University. All the relevant records of the CIA should be preserved by the Institute till the student passes out.

11.4 The passing minimum for ESE & MSE Theory shall be 33% and CPA & ESE Practical shall be 45% separately. Failed candidates in the Internal Assessment are permitted to improve their Internal Assessment marks by writing a re-test or by submitting assignments as per the decision of the Institute/ Authority.

12. Awarding of Degree

Degree will be awarded to a student provided; s/he fulfils the following conditions;

12.1 A student passes in all examinations and thus earns the required number of credits.

12.2 S/he completes the requirement of spending 30 hours during the period of three years in involving herself/himself in social work in order to raise the social consciousness of the students and make a small contribution to society. This could be in a village/NGO/Charitable Institutions or NSS or Adult Literacy Programme, etc. A declaration letter from the Institute regarding the completion of required number of hours to the University is a must.

12.3 Successful candidates shall be awarded the class/division at the end of sixth semester examination based on the aggregate of marks obtained in semester examinations consisting of 3000 marks.

12.4 The following is the categorization of successful candidates based on marks obtained by them

(a) 75% and above	First Class with Distinction
(b) 60% < 75%	First Class
(c) Rest successful candidates	Second Class

12.5 Each successful candidate of all the six semester taken together shall receive a certificate in the prescribed format, specifying the subject in which he/she was examined and the class is which he/she was placed.

12.6 A candidate who is placed first in the first class in the subject shall be awarded Gold Medal.

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12.7 Student shall be expected to complete the requirement for the award of BMFP in a minimum period of three consecutive years and a maximum period of four years from the date of admission. There shall be no relaxation in lower or upper time limit of the programme.

12.8 A student, who has secured less than 45% mark in any end semester evaluation (ESE) shall be allowed to appear only once for the improvement of marks.

12.9 The Vice-Chancellor may appoint a board moderation to look into all the examination conduct and result shall be published by the examination mode of Aryabhata Knowledge University, Patna.

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
